DRIVING SAFETY COURSE REQUIREMENTS

You may be able to have your traffic citation dismissed by successfully completing a DRIVING SAFETY COURSE if you comply with each and every one of the following conditions:

- 1. Enter a Plea: _____ Guilty or _____No Contest
- 2. Have a valid Class C Texas Driver's License. You are <u>not</u> eligible if you have a commercial driver's license (CDL) or an out-of-state driver's license.
- 3. Your citation is not for speeding 25 miles per hour or more over the posted speed limit.
- 4. Your citation is not for speeding at 95 miles per hour or more.
- 5. You present to the Court proof of liability insurance on the vehicle you were driving.
- 6. Make a written request on or before the appearance date on your ticket.
- 7. You have not taken a Driving Safety Course for another ticket in the previous 12 months from the date of this ticket; and
- 8. Complete this form and mail to the court with *copies* of: the ticket, your Driver's License, Liability Insurance, and court costs of **<u>\$146.00</u>** (see "Payment Methods")

When the Court receives the above items, you will receive further instructions by mail. It is your responsibility to inform the court of your present and correct mailing address.

"I have a valid Class C Texas Driver's License. I have not completed a Driving Safety Course within the past 12 months, nor have I completed one that is not yet reflected on my driving record. I can provide proof of liability insurance. I further understand that this statement MUST be signed and submitted to the Court with \$146.00 court costs by the appearance date on my citation to be eligible for a Driving Safety Course."
