## ORDER RESCINDING PROHIBITION OF OUTDOOR BURNING DATED September 23, 24

WHEREAS, in accordance with provisions of Chapter 418, Texas Government Code, a state of disaster was declared based on the imminent threat of disaster from wildfire; and

WHEREAS, rainfall countywide and the current weather conditions indicate disaster conditions no longer exist;

BE IT ORDERED that the Order dated September 23, 2024 prohibiting outdoor burning is hereby rescinded. Citizens are urged to exercise extreme caution when burning as follows:

- 1. Choose safe burning site
- 2. Have water source and hose at hand
- 3. Do not leave fires unattended
- 4. Be sure fires are completely extinguished
- 5. Notify 979-865-3112 when starting any controlled burn

Postpone burning when conditions are windy and/or red flag advisory is issued.

Negligently allowing your fire to escape onto someone else's property is a Class C misdemeanor offense punishable by a fine up to \$500.
