A RESOLUTION CANCELLING THE MAY 4, 2024 GENERAL ELECTION AND DECLARING EACH UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE ELECTED TO OFFICE

WHEREAS, in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, and the charter of the City of Robert Lee, a General Election has been ordered for May 4, 2024 for the purpose of electing a mayor and two (2) Councilmembers to serve in the City Council in the City of Robert Lee; and
