CONDUIT REQUESTED TO BE USED (SIZE, TYPE & LENGTH: _____

A minimum 6" diameter conduit shall be installed. Conduit shall be metal with 1/4" thick wall. Length of conduit will be determined by site characteristics. All trenches, ditches, or excavations shall be a minimum depth of 24" and may be required to be at a deeper depth based on site characteristics. All trenches, ditches, or excavations shall be back filled with concrete up to natural grade, and thereafter proper road materials will be re-applied.

Upon completion and approval in writing by designated county personnel, all conduits become the property of Real County.

REAL COUNTY COUNTY ROAD UNDERGROUND CONDUIT REQUIREMENTS

Minimum requirements for installation of underground conduits for purposes of installing water pipes, private electric lines, or private communications lines across or under a county road or county property:

1. Designated county personnel must be present at all times when construction of road or property crossing is in progress. No work is to be done without designated county personnel present.
2. Designated county personnel must approve in advance in writing all materials used and all installations. Future use of conduit will require an additional permit.
3. Location of road or property crossing must be approved in writing by designated county personnel and GPS location recorded.
4. All trenches, ditches, or excavations shall be a minimum depth of 24" and may be required to be at a deeper depth based on site characteristics.
5. A minimum 6" diameter conduit shall be installed. Conduit shall be Schedule 80 PVC or metal with 1/4" thick wall. Length of conduit will be determined by site characteristics.
6. All trenches, ditches, or excavations shall be back filled with concrete up to natural grade, and thereafter proper road materials will be re-applied.
7. Upon completion and approval in writing by designated county personnel, all conduits become the property of Real County.
