APPOINTMENT OF SUBSTITUTE TRUSTEE

THIS INSTRUMENT APPOINTS THE SUBSTITUTE TRUSTEE(S) IDENTIFIED TO SELL THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN THE SECURITY INSTRUMENT IDENTIFIED IN THIS NOTICE OF SALE. THE PERSON SIGNING THIS NOTICE IS THE ATTORNEY OR AUTHORIZED AGENT OF THE MORTGAGEE OR MORTGAGE SERVICER.

WHEREAS, on September 29, 2011, Brett Rhodes; and wife, Christy Rhodes executed a Deed of Trust conveying to Jacob G. Straub, Trustee, the real property hereinafter described, to secure Ronald Dean Lowe, in the payment of a debt therein described, said Deed of Trust being recorded in Document No. 001968, as corrected to include the legal description attached, Official Public Records of Falls County, Texas.

WHEREAS, default has occurred in the payment of said indebtedness, and the same is now wholly due, and the owner and holder of said debt has requested the hereinafter appointed Substitute Trustee to sell said property to the highest bidder for cash and to distribute or apply the proceeds of said sale in accordance with the terms of said Deed of Trust.

NOW, THEREFORE, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Tuesday, December 1, 2020, at 10:00 o'clock a.m. or within three (3) hours thereafter, the Substitute Trustee will sell said real property at the place hereinafter set out, to the highest bidder for cash. The place of sale shall be in the area designated by the Commissioners Court of such County, pursuant to §51.002 of the Texas Property Code as the place where foreclosure sales are to take place (if such place is not so designated, the sale will take place in the area where this Notice of Substitute Trustee's Sale is posted), in the City of Marlin, Falls County, Texas.

Said real property is described as follows:

Being 13.239 ac. land, more or less, in the J. A. MANCHACA GRANT, Falls County, Texas, being more particularly described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes and a 30 ft. easement and right of way along the E line of

a 25.8 ac. tract in the J. A. MANCHACA GRANT, Falls County, Texas being more particularly described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes.

The Deed of Trust permits the Beneficiary to postpone, withdraw, or reschedule the sale for another day. In that case, the Trustee under the Deed of Trust or Substitute Trustee appointed herein need not appear at the date, time and place of a scheduled sale to announce the postponement, withdrawal, or rescheduling. Notice of the date of any rescheduled foreclosure sale will be reposted and refiled in accordance with the posting and filing requirements of the Texas Property Code. The reposting or refileing may be after the date originally scheduled for this sale.

Pursuant to Section 51.009 of the Texas Property Code, the property will be sold in "AS IS, WHERE IS" condition, without any express or implied warranties, except as to the warranties of title (if any) provided for under the Deed of Trust. Prospective bidders are advised to conduct an independent investigation of the nature and physical condition of the property and the priority of the lien being foreclosed.

The sale will be conducted as a public auction to the highest bidder for cash, subject to the provisions of the Deed of Trust permitting the Beneficiary thereunder to have the bid credited to the Note up to the amount of the unpaid debt secured by the Deed of Trust at the time of sale.

Those desiring to purchase the property will need to demonstrate their ability to pay their bid immediately in cash if their bid is accepted.

The sale will be made expressly subject to any title matters set forth in the Deed of Trust, but prospective bidders are reminded that by law the sale will necessarily be made subject to all prior matters of record affecting the property, if any, to the extent that they remain in force and effect and have not been subordinated to the Deed of Trust. All that certain tract or parcel of land out of the J. A. Manchaca Grant west of the Brazos River in Falls County, Texas, being part of a 26 acre tract described in a deed to C. E. Mortimer recorded in Vol. 341, Pg. 184 of the Falls County Deed Records and described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at the SW corner of said 26 acre tract;

THENCE N 28°W 675 feet to stake for corner;

THENCE N 53° 18' E 228.5 feet;

THENCE N 76° 53' E 177.5 feet for corner;

THENCE N 61° 5' E 458.3 feet to the east line of said tract;

THENCE S 28° E 662.5 feet to its SE corner;

THENCE S 61° 25' W 855.8 feet with its south line to the place of beginning, containing 13.239 acres of land.
