

Order Adopting 2022 Tax Rate for Falls County

“I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of .81591 which is effectively an 11.5% (percentage by which the proposed tax rate exceeds the effective tax rate) percent decrease in the tax rate.” Tax Code 26.05(b)

“THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR’S TAX RATE,” Tax Code 26.05(b)(1)(A)

Whereas, the Falls County Commissioners Court find it necessary to increase the tax rate levied by 11.5% for 2022 in order to provide funds with which to meet the budget requirements of the County, and to pay expenses necessarily incurred in connection with the services provided by the County to Falls County residents: therefore,

BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT:

That there is hereby levied and there shall be assessed and collected for 2022 an ad valorem tax of \$0.81591 per \$100 assessed valuation on all taxable property within the county as shown on the final approved 2022 tax rolls of the county.


This 2022 tax rate is hereby adopted in the following components:

<u>Debt Service-Interest and Sinking fund- Tax Rate</u>	<u>\$0.02391</u>
Total County	\$0.69391
FMLR-(farm to market lateral road)- Tax Rate	\$0.12200
2022 Total Ad Valorem Tax Rate	\$0.81591

That the Falls County Tax Office is hereby authorized and directed to prepare 2022 tax statements and transmit same to the owners of taxable property within the County on or before October 1, 2022, or as soon thereafter as possible.




