BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 27th day of February, A.D. 2017 the Commissioner Court of Howard County met in regular session at 3:30 PM with KATHYRN G. WISEMAN, County Judge as the Presiding Officer. The following members were present: OSCAR GARCIA, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, CRAIG BAILEY, Commissioner Precinct No. 2 and JIMMIE LONG and Commissioner Precinct No. 3. JOHN H. CLINE, Commissioner Precinct No. 4 was absent.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Garcia to approve the Election Judges and Alternates for the upcoming May 6, 2017 Election as presented by Jodi Duck, Elections Administrator. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Long to approve the Jail Commissary Audit as presented by Jackie Olson, County Auditor and to transfer \$18,829.54 from commissary to the General Fund. They will post to cleaning supplies-Jail and to inmate supplies-Jail and this would be a new line item. However, they are allowed to charge the Commissary account with salaries/benefits of employees who work in that department so we would transfer from the General Fund to the Commissary Fund to cover that expense. In the future they will post accordingly. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Long and seconded by Commissioner Garcia to approve the bills as presented and the 2 extra travel bills for the County and District Clerk as presented by Jackie Olson, County Auditor. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Garcia and seconded by Commissioner Long to approve the following purchase request as presented by Jackie Olson, County Auditor: Appraisal – Shelving supplies from Higginbotham @ \$250.00 and Sheriff – 47 shirts from Anderson Uniform @ \$2087.88 plus one late request from Volunteer Fire Department for a transmission from NAPPA@ \$3875.00. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

There were no budget amendments on this date.

A motion was made by Commissioner Long and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to approve the Financial Report as presented by Jackie Olson, County Auditor. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

Brian Klinksiek, County Road Administrator presented the Court with a request to hire a retiree as a part time employee for 29 hours a week for the rest of this fiscal year. No action could be taken since it wasn't on the agenda. It will have to be placed on the next agenda.

Teresa Thomas, County Treasurer had no personnel considerations on this date but she did report that our MET workers were about to all be gone.

A motion was made by Commissioner Garcia and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to approve the following 10 Right of Ways as presented by Brian Klinksiek, County Road Administrator: 3 to Outrigger Midland Operating on County Rd. 42, 29 & 48; 1 to Oxy USA on Stallings Rd; 1 to Legacy on County Rd. 36; 3 to SM Energy on Jeffery Rd, Craig Rd & Hughes Rd. and 1 to Medallion Pipeline Company LLC on Centerpoint Rd. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.
