BE IT REMEMBERED that on 22nd the day of March, A.D. 2021 the Commissioner Court of Howard County met in Budget Workshop session @ 3:00 PM and Regular session at 3:30 PM with **KATHYRN G. WISEMAN**, County Judge as the Presiding Officer. The following members were present: **EDDILISA RAY**, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, **CRAIG BAILEY**, Commissioner Precinct No. 2 (absent for Workshop), **JIMMIE LONG**, Commissioner Precinct No. 3 and **JOHN H. CLINE**, Commissioner Precinct No. 4.

The Budget Workshop was called to order @ 3:03 PM.

Brian Klinksiek, County Road Administrator, discussed with the Commissioners the need to move funds around within the various funds for acceleration of his Letting Schedule for the remainder of the year ending in 2021. No action taken during the Budget Workshop.

Commissioner Cline told fellow Commissioners that he would be putting Easements and Bonuses with oil companies on the next agenda.

The Court moved into Closed/Executive session @ 3:12 PM Pursuant to Local Government Code 551.

Court reconvened in Regular session @ 3:38 PM with no action taken as a result of the Closed/Executive session.

Jackie Olson, County Auditor, introduced Becky Roberts of Roberts & McGee, CPA. Ms. Roberts presented the Howard County, Texas Financial Statements and Independent Auditor's Report for Year Ended September 30, 2020. She stated there were no errors found that needed mentioned and complimented Jackie Olson, County Auditor, on the job she and her staff does. She also answered questions from the Court.

Judge Wiseman presented the Court with her Judicial Education Record for the Fiscal Year Reporting Period 09/01/2020 - 08/31/2021 pointing out she is carrying forward an excess of 9 hours. No action necessary.

A motion was made by Commissioner Ray and seconded by Commissioner Cline to accept the Howard County, Texas Financial Statements and Independent Auditor's Report for year ended September 30, 2020 as presented by Becky Roberts of Roberts & McGee CPA. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Long and seconded by Commissioner Ray to approve the Amendment to the Food Services Agreement between Howard County Jail and Trinity Services Group, Inc. as presented by Stan Parker, Sheriff and Irene Buchanan, Chief Deputy. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried. Sharon Adams, County Treasurer, presented her 2019 and 2020 Certificate of Compliance Continuing Education. In addition, she presented her 2019 Certificate of Compliance Public Funds Investment Act statement that she will need to complete an additional 5 hours of training by 12/31/2021 to fulfil the 10 hours continuing education every 2 years for the Public Funds Investment Act. No action necessary.

Commissioner Long reported that he completed his continuing education hours for 2020 with 8 hours to carry over. No action necessary.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Cline to approve the Personnel Considerations as presented by Sharon Adams, County Treasurer. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Long and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to approve the Treasurer's Monthly Report for February 2021 as presented by Sharon Adams, County Treasurer. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Ray and seconded by Commissioner Cline to approve the Treasurer's Monthly Payroll Report for March 2021 as presented by Sharon Adams, County Treasurer. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Long to Extend the Families First Coronavirus Response Act until September 30, 2021. This decision was made after discussion among the Court after Sharon Adams, County Treasurer, asked whether or not to continue. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Ray to approve the Depository Bid for Howard County 2021-2023 with Prosperity Bank as presented by Sharon Adams, County Treasurer. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Long and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to approve the Invoices as presented by Jackie Olson, County Auditor. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Ray to approve the Purchase Requests, excluding library flooring, as presented by Jackie Olson, County Auditor. The requests are as follows: Detention Center for Monitor from New Egg @ \$1350; Elections for envelopes/shucks from Conley Printing @ \$2906.90; Sheriff for four new vehicle window guards @ \$828.28; Library for Meraki wifi hubs license from GDT @ \$1850.55; Library for Steam kits from Penworthy @ \$1236.90; Road & Bridge supplies from Centerline @ \$6304; and Jail for water heater and parts from Morrison Supply @ \$5146. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

There were no Budget Amendments on this date.

Jackie Olson, County Auditor, reported that Howard County will be receiving an estimated \$7.1 million allocation from the State and Local Coronavirus Fiscal Recovery Funds. No action necessary.

Jackie Olson, County Auditor, reported that the County has requested reimbursement from FEMA for storm damage to the Courthouse steps, roads and the Radio Tower that collapsed during recent winter storms. No action necessary.

A motion was made by Commissioner Ray and seconded by Commissioner Bailey to approve line item transfers within the Road & Bridge funds to accelerate the Letting Schedule for the remainder of the Fiscal Year 2021 as presented by Brian Klinksiek, County Road Administrator. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cline and seconded by Commissioner Bailey giving permission to go on bid for Project 2020014, 2020015 and 2020016 as requested by Brian Klinksiek, County Road Administrator. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cline and seconded by Commissioner Long to award the low bid on RFB 2020012 to Dorado Construction Group @ \$550628.38 and RFB 2020013 to Cox Paving @ \$133439.76 as presented by Brian Klinksiek, County Road Administrator. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.

Brian Klinksiek, County Road Administrator, gave a CTIF Grant update. No action needed.

Brian Klinksiek, County Road Administrator, gave Roadway Maintenance updates reporting that by the end of the week there will be eight (8) maintenance projects in process. No action needed.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Ray to adjourn @ 4:31 PM. A vote was taken and the members of the Court unanimously voted "AYES". Motion carried.
