

COMMISSIONERS' COURT ORDER

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2025, the County Judge issued a proclamation declaring a state of disaster for Howard County resulting from severe storms, hail, and straight-line winds;

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating declaration of a state of disaster continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period of excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT [ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT of HOWARD COUNTY:

1. That the state of disaster proclaimed for Howard County by the County Judge on June 9, 2025 shall continue for 30 days or until terminated by order of the HOWARD COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT.
2. This ordinance is passed as an emergency measure and shall become effective on the 16th day of June, 2025.
