A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF EARLY, TEXAS ORDERING A REGULAR CITY GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 3rd DAY OF MAY, 2025; DESIGNATING THE POLLING PLACE AND APPOINTING ELECTION OFFICIALS FOR SUCH ELECTION; DIRECTING THE GIVING OF NOTICE OF SUCH ELECTION; AND PROVIDING DETAILS RELATING TO THE HOLDING OF SUCH ELECTION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EARLY, TEXAS:

Section 1: It is hereby ordered that a General Election be held in the City of Early on the 3rd day of May, 2025, at which election the following officers shall be elected by the qualified voters of the City:

POSITION General Election: Mayor and Two (2) at large Council Members

Section 2: Filing for the General Election shall begin on January 15, 2025 and end on February 14, 2025.

Section 3: The present boundaries of the City constituting one election precinct, the polls shall be open for voting from seven (7:00) am until seven (7:00) pm at the following polling place: Early First Baptist Church

103 Garmon Drive Early, TX 76802

Election officers shall be appointed by Brown County Elections Administrator to assist in holding the election.

Section 4: The Brown County Elections Administrator is hereby appointed clerk for early voting and shall appoint a deputy clerk or clerks for early voting. The place for early voting for such election is hereby designated as:

613 N. Fisk Suite 200 Brownwood, TX 76801

Section 5: All ballots shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code. AutoMark Direct Recording Electronic (DRE) Voting System shall be used in said election. All expenditures necessary for the conduct of the election, the purchase of materials and the employment of all election officials is hereby authorized.

Section 6: The Brown County Elections Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to furnish all necessary election supplies to conduct such election.

Section 7: Notice of this election shall be given in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code. The Mayor shall issue all necessary orders

and writs for such election, and returns of such election shall be made to the City Secretary after the closing of the polls.

Section 8: Said election shall be held in accordance with Texas Election Code and the Federal Voting Rights Acts of 1965, as amended.
