

MAY, 2020 ELECTIONS POSTPONED

On March 18, 2020, the Governor of the State of Texas issued a proclamation suspending certain provisions of the Texas Election Code and the Texas Water Code to allow all local political subdivisions that are utilizing the May 2, 2020 uniform election date to postpone their election to the November 3, 2020 uniform election date.

There were three elections contracted with the Llano County Elections Department for the May 2, 2020 Joint Local Election. The Llano Independent School District Board of Trustees issued an Order to postpone the election date due to COVID-19 Emergency to November 3, 2020 on March 18, 2020. Kingsland Municipal Utility District (KMUD) Board of Directors Ordered to Postpone to November 3, 2020 on March 23, 2020. The City of Llano City Council Ordered to Postpone to their election to November 3, 2020 on April 6, 2020.

In the meantime, Absentee Mail Ballots were required to be mailed to voters who had applied for mail ballots. The Llano ISD and KMUD elections were deleted from the ballot programming since those elections had been postponed. The City of Llano Election ballot was mailed to those voters entitled to receive a mail ballot for the City of Llano Election to be held on May 2, 2020.

Ballots mailed to City of Llano mail ballot voters are being processed as they are received by the Elections Office and are deposited in the ballot box. These ballots will be processed on November 3, 2020 along with the General Election ballots.

Candidate filings for all three elections will remain valid for the election held on November 3, 2020 and the filing period will not be re-opened.

Voter registration deadline for the November 3, 2020 election is October 5, 2020.

Deadline to submit an absentee mail ballot application is October 23, 2020.

Early Voting is October 19 – Oct 30, 2020.

On March 24, 2020 the Governor issued a proclamation that moves the 2020 Primary Runoff Election date to July 14, 2020.

Early Voting is July 6 – July 10, 2020.

Voter registration deadline is June 15, 2020.

Deadline to submit an absentee mail ballot application is July 2, 2020.
