This position performs a variety of duties to include; general maintenance and repair of county buildings, routine preventative maintenance, assisting in repairs to mechanical equipment and utility systems, yard maintenance and custodial duties.

Essential Functions:

- Performs minor repairs of all buildings and equipment; assists with major repairs under supervision of a licensed maintenance technician, repairs locks and control panel for security
- Performs general maintenance to include; changing light bulbs, air conditioning filters, windows, doors etc.
- Performs preventive maintenance on mechanical equipment as scheduled to include inspection of belts, fluid levels, filters, grease bearings, seals, cleans and inspects boiler and chiller
- Installs and or replaces electrical wiring and equipment for new services or remodels;
 install computer cable
