Subject: RFP 2022-261 Centerville Tower Shelter

Commissioner Court Action Requested:

It is respectfully requested that the Commissioners Court reject all proposals for the RFP 2022-261, Centerville Tower Project, and grant to rebid with revised procurement standards.

Background:

Notice of the County's intent to bid was advertised in local newspapers, as required by State statute, and posted on the Leon County website. Nine vendors were contacted and requested to participate in the proposal process. Application closing was on September 15, 2021, at 3:00 PM CDT with two proposals being received for this project. The proposals were scored by the scoring committee on September 21, 2021. Negotiations commenced with the vendors. Negotiations had already concluded when it was brought to our attention that the 2 CFR 200 procurement standards included with the RFP were out of date and therefore not compliant with federal regulations.

Therefore, it is the recommendation of the Leon County Auditor's Office that the Commissioners Court reject all proposals received for RFP 2022-261, Centerville Tower Shelter, and grant permission to rebid with updated procurement standards.
