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# AEP ANNEX BUILDING NETWORK CONNECTIVITY

- County is making use of office space in former AEP building and is re-locating the County Agent & Elections Office to this building. This building is currently not served by the county's network.
  - o Establish Connectivity to AEP Building (117 W Chestnut)
    - Network Access to County Servers
    - Internet Access with Secure Firewall & Redundant Internet
    - WiFi Access
    - Phone Service
    - Fax Service
- Because the Elections office is a part of this move security of extending the network should be at the forefront of any design or consideration. The Election Security assessment in 2020 outlined the goals and needs for election security, this move should at the least meet the existing state of security, if not improve on it.

There are 3 options to accomplish this move.

Timeframes, Recurring Cost, and Security are the primary considerations.

On the following page we have outlined the 3 options.

Option 3 is what we see as the best long-term solution. This has a higher up-front (one-time) cost than one of the options, but a <u>lower cost</u> of future maintenance and a <u>lower cost</u> of ongoing monthly telecom fees.

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#### OPTION 1

NOT RECOMMENDED DUE TO ON-GOING MONTHLY COSTS, THIS SETUP REQUIRES DUPLICATING A LOT OF THE EXISITING IT SERVICES ON THE COURTHOUSE. SIDE OF THE STREET.

- Install New Fiber Internet with Windstream
  - Windstream DSL is not recommended to be used as it can not support the upload speeds required for election equipment, phones, backups of computer systems
- Install Backup Internet Connection at Site as needed for Election compliance
- Install & Maintain New Firewall at Site for Security



#### OPTION 2

NOT RECOMMENDED DUE TO ON-GOING EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT COSTS AND LOWER RELIABILITY OF WIRELESS CONNECTIVITY

- Install New Licensed Internet Point to Point Wireless between AEP Building & Annex to connect new site to County Network
- Point to Point Wireless Equipment would need to be replaced every 6-9 years.

- Install County Owned Fiber between AEP Building & Annex to connect new site to county network
- Establish Temporary unlicensed Wireless Link to building to get services up and running faster while fiber build out is underway.

Timeframe (Temporary Solution) 14 business days
Timeframe (Permanent Solution) 60-90 days

Fiber Cable is expected to last 20+ years.


