Throckmorton County Commissioners' Court met in Regular Session on Monday the 10th day of June, 2024, at 9:00 a.m., at 105 North Minter, Throckmorton, Texas, with the following members present:

- 1. Caleb Hodges called meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. and welcomed guest. Casey Wells was absent.
