Driving Safety Course or Motorcycle Operator Training Course

You may request that a charge be dismissed by successfully completing a driving safety course, a motorcycle operator training course, or a specialized driving safety course if eligible.

You will lose that right if, on or before your appearance date, you do not provide the court with notice of your request to take the course.

ELIGIBILITY: for Driving Safety Course or Motorcycle Operator Training Course You are **NOT** eligible for this option if you answer **YES** to any of the following questions:

1. Do you hold a commercial driver's license?
2. Did you take a driving safety, a motorcycle operator training or specialized driving safety course within the 12 months preceding the date of this offense?
3. Did this offense occur in a Construction or Maintenance Work Zone?
4. Were you speeding 25 mph or more over the posted speed limit, or 95 mph or more?
5. Is your ticket for an offense other than a moving traffic violation?
6. Were you cited for not having a valid Texas Driver's License?
7. Were you charged with a violation of a state law related to motor vehicle traffic control, including a law regulating the operation of vehicles on highways, arising in connection with a fatal accident, i.e., improper or erratic traffic lane change or following the vehicle ahead too closely?

REQUESTING a Driving Safety Course or Motorcycle Operator Training Course

The following documents must be brought to the court:

- COPY OF INSURANCE COVERAGE
- COPY OF DRIVER'S LICENSE
- PLEA FORM
- Affidavit form (will be notarized by Court Clerk)
- CASH, MONEY ORDER, CASHIER'S CHECK, CREDIT/DEBIT CARD (convenience fee apply) in the EXACT amount of \$144.00
- Pay the fees by money order or cashier's check made payable to, Justice of the Peace, Precinct 2
- A course must be approved by the Texas Education Agency as required under Code of Criminal Procedures § 45.0511(b)

INSTRUCTIONS AFTER taking a Driving Safety Course or Motorcycle Operator Training Course

The following documents **MUST** be brought to the court in person or sent by certified mail, return receipt:

- Original Driver's Safety Course Certificate of Completion or Motorcycle Operator Training Course Verification of Completion and a copy of your driving record from the TEXAS DPS by the due date given or request is voided.

The certificate must also name the court where the citation has been filed for whom you are taking the course, Justice of the Peace, Precinct 2

Note: A violation for No Seat Belt of a passenger 5 years or younger will require the Specialized Driving Safety Course
