- 7. Pay claims and line-item adjustments as requested by the County Auditor.**

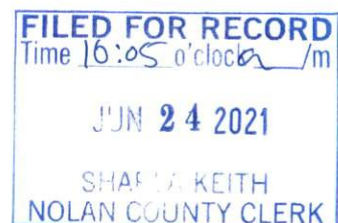


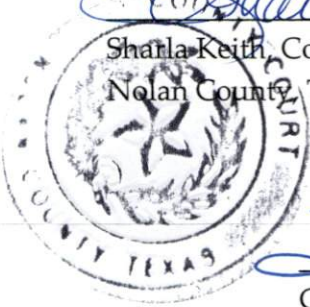
8. ADJOURN






