

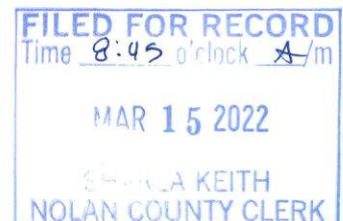
1. Consider approval of an Electricity Provider Contract.

with County Clerk, Sharla Keith and County Commissioner, Tommy White presiding, to wit:

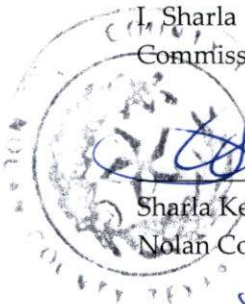
1. CONSIDER APPROVAL OF AN ELECTRICITY PROVIDER CONTRACT.
