**8. Receive reports from Department Heads.**

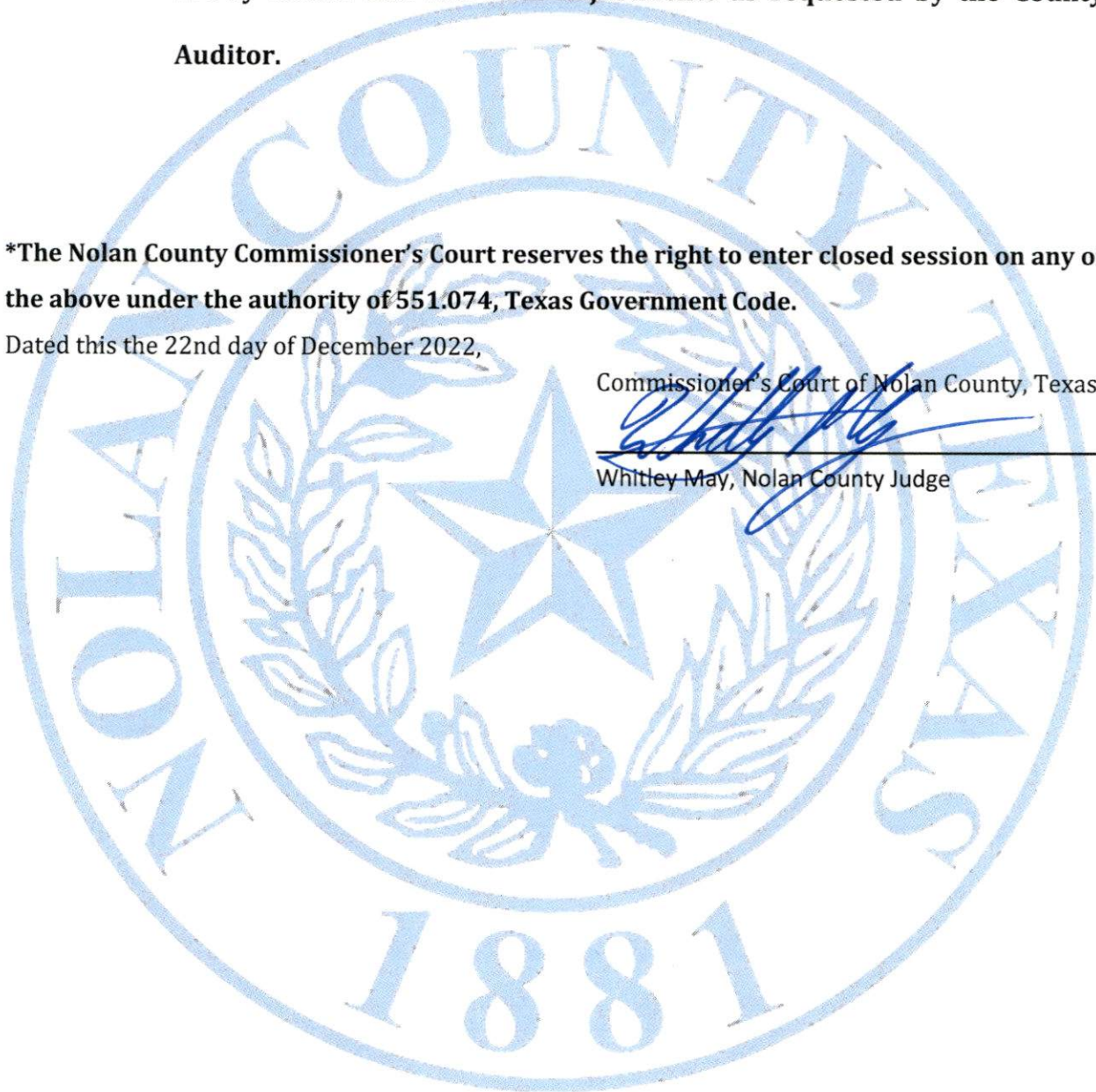
**9. Pay claims and line-item adjustments as requested by the County Auditor.**

**10. ADJOURN.**






