

## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING CLERK'S DUTY TO NOTIFY COURT UPON FILING OF MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

The Hunt County Courts at Law find that there is a need for an administrative order regarding the clerk's duty to notify the Court upon the filing of a Motion for Summary Judgment.

Recently, the Texas Legislature passed SB 293 and HB 16 requiring the court to act within prescribed periods after the filing of a motion for summary judgment.

Therefore, upon the filing of a motion for summary judgement, the clerk shall notify the appropriate court coordinator of the filing of the motion for summary judgment.

Each Court shall notify the Clerk of the manner in which notification shall be made by the Clerk to the Court.
