

PIPELINE ROAD CROSSING REGULATIONS

1. No County road may be crossed by a pipeline except by approved application to the San Augustine County Commissioner's Court. The application must be submitted with a plat and specifications for the proposed activity and application fee of \$ 500.00 payable to San Augustine County, Texas. It is expressly understood that San Augustine County, Texas does not purport hereby to grant any right, claim, title, or easement in or upon the county road or property at issue.

2. _____ successors and assigns shall hold harmless and indemnify San Augustine County, Texas and the Commissioners Court of San Augustine County, Texas against any and all damages to property or injuries to persons, including the legal defense thereof, caused in whole or in part, by the proposed construction. Further, by submission of the application, _____, successor and assigns, agrees to make changes and alterations to the pipeline as may be required in connection with alteration, paving, or relocation of any public or county road, without cost to San Augustine County, Texas.

3. The County, unless exception is made, shall require all crossings of county roads to be by bore and not by cutting or ditching the county road. All roads bores must place the top of the pipe at least five feet deep from the bottom of the road ditch, and run thirty foot from the center of the road on each side. The Commissioner of the precinct must be given forty eight hour notice prior to the bore and he or his representative shall be present at the time of the bore. All roads bores shall occur between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. A sign shall be place on the road forty eight hours in advance advising residents of the road bore, and appropriate sign, flagmen, or safety personal shall be on the road during the bore to ensure the safety of residents and persons using the road.

4. Any persons, or entity seeking to cross a county road shall submit a written application to the San Augustine County Judge setting forth the road and exact location of the proposed pipeline crossing and describing the pipeline in detail including, but not limited to its, size, or diameter, well thickness, and the requested method of crossing the road. (i.e. a road cut or bore)

5. All persons, companies, and entities seeking to use the county road in connection with a pipeline bore or drill, including all equipment operators and truck drivers, shall complete and obtain a Pipeline Road Crossing Application approved by the Commissioners Court and executed by the commissioner of the precinct in which the county road is located.

6. In the event that an open cut road crossing be allowed, the following minimum requirements shall be required:
 - a. A sign shall be placed on the road and notice circulated in a local newspaper for seven (7) days prior to submitting the application to commissioners court advising residents and persons using the road of the proposed action;
 - b. The crossing shall maintain a minimum depth of five (5) feet from the top of the pipe for thirty (30) feet on each side of the road;

7. Open cut crossings shall be back filled with sand around the pipe and with twelve (12) inches cover over the pipe, then continue the backfilling process with a minimum (3) sack Flow-Able Fill Material to a point within twelve (12) of the existing road surface. The road will be platted to allow adequate time for curing and settlement and the remainder will be backfilled with approved road base material. The base will be installed in lifts and compacted to equal or greater density than the existing road conditions for a distance of at least 100 foot on each side of the cut.
