GENERAL DUTIES

General duties include qualifying and assisting voters to ensure voters are able to exercise their
rights and that everyone receives a secure and private vote as prescribe by the Texas Election
Law, Federal and other State laws.

REQUIREMENTS

- Qualifications as set by Sec 32 of the Texas Election Code.
- Must be a registered voter of Refugio County.
- May not hold an elected public official or candidate for office.
- Must complete training as required.
- Excellent interpersonal skills in order to interact, cooperate, and deal effectively with coworkers, voters, poll watchers, electioneers, and the public.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills.
- Ability to read, comprehend and follow Texas Election Laws and instructions given by the Refugio County Elections Administrator.
- Demonstrate how to use the voting equipment
- Basic computer skills and/or familiarity with technology.
- Able to take direction well and not easily distracted.
- Attention to detail.
- Ability to stand and sit of long periods of time.
- Occasionally lift and carry objects weighing up to 30 pounds (e.g. election equipment, ballots, supply boxes, etc).
- Available to work 12-15 hours on Election Day, or as directed by the Election Judge.
- Ability to work long shifts, weekends, and rotating schedules.
- Ability to travel to polling locations.
- Must complete forms and provide documents, as required, for payroll (Including a copy of driver's license and social security card).
