BID DOCUMENT:

NOTICE ACCEPTING BIDS ON BEHALF OF THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT WITH THE CITY OF ELKHART, TEXAS FOR TWO (2) GENERATORS. ONE (1) STAND ALONE AND ONE (1) TOWABLE GENERATOR.

Anderson County is accepting bids on behalf of the Hazard Mitigation Grant with the city of Elkhart, Texas for two (2) generators. One (1) stand alone and one (1) towable generator.

Specifications to purchase and install:

One (1) 20KW natural gas connection stand by generator with a 200 amp service entrance rated ATS (Automatic Transfer Switch) that will be installed in Elkhart, Texas located at City Hall 110 W. Parker St. Elkhart, Texas 75839. Installation will include a pad for the generator and any installation materials such as wiring, connectors, grounding etc. Gas hookup will already be established at the location for generator connection.

BID PRICING FOR STAND ALONE GENERATOR: _____

One (1) 60Hz ***48KW 120/208 voltage three phase*** towable generator for the City of Elkhart Public Works to be used at the wastewater facility. This generator will be used at any of the seven (7) lift stations for power loss occurrences.

Must include pricing to install connections at each of the seven (7) lift stations to ensure the ability to plug in for operation such as cables, connectors, amps, switches etc. The level of connections will be different for each lift station.

EXHIBIT B: INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Insurance:

PRIOR TO STARTING THE CONTRACT WORK the contractor shall procure and maintain in force general liability, automobile liability, and worker's compensation insurance for the duration of the work.

- a. Commercial General Liability insurance** from an insurer licensed to do business in Texas that is financially sound. The insurance should be written with limits of a least \$500,000 per occurrence and an aggregate limit of at least \$1,000,000. The insurance must include coverage for bodily injury, property damage, contractual liability, products and completed operations, and personal injury.
- b. Workers Compensation and Employer's Liability insurance** from an insurer that is licensed to do business in Texas. The Workers' Compensation insurance should be written with statutory limits of liability. The Employer's Liability insurance should be written with limits of at least \$500,000 each employee for occupational disease.
- c. Commercial Automobile Liability insurance** from an insurer that is licensed to do business in Texas should be written with bodily injury and property damage limits of at least \$500,000 combined and should apply in regard to any automobile, including owned, non-owned, hired and borrowed automobiles.
- d. Any subcontractor(s) hired by the contractor shall maintain insurance coverage equal to that required of the contractor. It is the responsibility of the contractor to assure compliance with this provision. Anderson County accepts no responsibility arising from the conduct of the subcontractor.**

Davis-Bacon Act:

If this work has federal funding, work in this contract is subject to prevailing wage requirements for both the State (RCW Chapter 39.12) and federal (Davis-Bacon and related acts), if such work has applicable wage category. The contractor and all subs must then comply with the Davis-Bacon Act and related acts as supplemented by the Department of Labor regulations.
