

Advertisement and Invitation for Bids

The Duval County will receive bids for TxCDBG CFC 24-0103 until 1:00 PM on Monday, July 6th, 2026 at Duval County Courthouse, 400 East Gravis Avenue, San Diego, Texas 78384 The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 1:00 PM on Monday, July 6th, 2026 at Duval County Courthouse, 400 East Gravis Avenue, San Diego, Texas 78384.

Bids are invited for several items and quantities of work as follows:

The project consists of lift station improvements for the Cadena and La Masa lift stations. Work includes mobilization, traffic control and barricades, demolition and proper disposal of existing chain-link fencing and lift station components, installation of new 6-foot chain-link fencing with barbed wire and double gates, concrete slab construction, ductile iron piping improvements, pump replacement, control panel upgrades, generator installation with automatic transfer switches, and bypass pumping as needed. The project also includes storm water pollution prevention measures such as silt fencing, trash and debris containment, and concrete truck washout pits.

Copies of the Bid/Contract Documents may be obtained by depositing \$100 with the Engineer for each set of documents obtained. The deposit will be refunded if the documents and drawings are returned in good condition within 10 days following the bid opening. A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid [for those contracts that exceed \$100,000]. A certified check or bank draft payable to the Duval County or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the federally determined prevailing (Davis-Bacon and Related Acts) wage rate, as issued by the Texas Department of Agriculture Office of Rural Affairs and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual identity, gender identity, or national origin. All contractors and subcontractors must be cleared (not suspended or debarred) prior to any formal action authorizing the award of a contract to the contractor. Minority Business Enterprises, Small Business Enterprises, Women Business Enterprises, Veteran-Owned Businesses, and Section 3 Businesses are encouraged to submit bids.

This solicitation is for services related to a project that is subject to the Build America, Buy America Act (BABA) requirements under Title IX of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act. Absent an approved waiver, all iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials used in this project must be produced in the United States.

The Duval County reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding. Bids may be held by Duval County for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award.
