## **WHAT TO EXPECT**

### **Are you registered?**

Check whether you are registered to vote. Review instructions & guidelines for eligibility to voter and how to register. Request voter registration forms.

*Please note that you must already be a registered voter 30 days before election day to be eligible to vote.*

### **What to Expect.**

Bowie County utilizes the Election System and Software system in all its polling locations. You will need to present an approved form of ID. You will be provided a voting activation card (paper ballot) that is specific to what you are eligible to vote for. You will choose from a slate of candidates, review your ballot after you have selected your favorite, and then deposit your ballot in the tabulator. ### **Where to Vote**

If you are voting in person during the **Early Voting** period, you may vote at any early voting polling location.

If you are voting on **Election Day**, you may vote at any of the 25 convenient Voting Centers.

### **Identification**

When you arrive, you will be asked for identification. Valid forms of ID include:

- Voter ID Card
- Valid Texas Driver's License
- Passport
