



ELECTION WORKER INFORMATION

Poll workers are critical to the success of an election. Having an adequate number of poll workers to staff polling places on and before Election Day can ensure voters receive the assistance they need and can help provide a positive and smooth voting experience for all voters.

- All election workers must complete, sign and date the following prior to working an election.
 - Election Worker Application
 - Current Years W4 Form
 - Direct Deposit Form (If this form is not completed the worker shall receive a check via USPS Mail)
 - A copy of your current unexpired Driver's License
 - A copy of your Social Security Card
- All election workers must be a current resident and a registered voter in Bowie County. All election workers must successfully complete the appropriate online training course and obtain a copy of your Certificate of Completion. Certificates are valid 1 Year from the date issued and must be on file in our office prior to working the upcoming election. Poll Workers only need to complete ONE course: "Online Poll Worker Training" This may be completed online at your convenience prior to the election and is not compensated.
