- 1) A quorum will be established, and the meeting of Milam County ESD #1 will be called to order.
  - A quorum was present with Commissioners Kain Dodd, Kimberly Knapek, and Stephen Hanel attending in person. Commissioners Mikel Reed and Rebecca Gerren attended the meeting via Zoom. President Kain Dodd called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m..

  - b. Adopt Texas State Library and Archives Commission, Local Schedule TX for Records of Property Taxation, Third Edition, Effective April 3, 201 13 TAC §7.125(a)(9)
