

Many have been inquiring about the biennial voter registration cards.

They have been delayed this year due to circumstances beyond our control.

But they will be sent out soon.

Meanwhile, you can verify your voter status by using our website, 2 ways:

There is an alphabetized list of names only of current registered voters.

There is a link to the state website where you can enter your own information, entitled "Am I Registered to Vote?" Both are found under General Voter Information, first two items.

Please Remember: you do NOT have to have your voter's card to vote. But you DO have to have a photo ID. There are 7 acceptable forms of ID on List A.

Even though cards are late this year, you are still registered to vote, if you have regularly voted elections.

Only if you are convicted of a felony crime are you removed from the voter roll.

If you move and do not update your address, you will be in suspense until you show up to vote and update your address. It's best to update in advance of an election.

We do remove deceased people daily from the voter roll.

Early voting for the Democratic and Republican Primary Elections will begin on Tuesday February 17th at seven locations.

If you can please vote early.

The MAIN election office will also be open Saturday February 21 from 7-7 and Sunday February 22 from 1-7.

The MAIN election office will also be open 7-7 every day of the second week, the last of February. ONLY Thursday February 26th will the other locations be open 7-7
