EASTMAN CHEMICAL COMPANY, INC. AND AIR LIQUIDE LARGE
INDUSTRIES US LP**

Notice is hereby given that the Commissioners Court of Harrison County will hold a Public Hearing at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, February 26, 2020 in the Commissioners Courtroom of the Harrison County Historic Courthouse on the second floor located at #1 Peter Whetstone Square Marshall, Texas to consider proposed Tax Abatement Agreements for Eastman Chemical Company, Inc. and Air Liquide Large Industries US LP located in the newly created Re-Investment Zone No. One which covers the entire Eastman Chemical Company, Inc. property in western Harrison County. The improvements to be abated a new 138 KV transformer, associated work/equipment, piping networks and consuming facilities, downstream production facilities, and a new Syngas-POX3 and Air Separation Unit-ASUS assets. Eastman Chemicals portion will cost approximately \$40,000,000 and Air Liquide's expansion will cost approximately \$158,000,000.

Harrison County encourages interested citizens to attend such Public Hearing and there offer such comments and evidence, either for or against the proposed tax abatements, as may be proper and relevant.

A copy of the tax abatement application and tax abatement policy may be examined at the Office of the County Judge for Harrison County, Texas 3rd floor, Room 314, Harrison County Historic Courthouse prior to such public hearing and during ordinary business hours.
