FIELDNOTES

BEING 0.259 acres known as the William P. Johnston Cemetery out of Block 74, Ben Hill Survey, Abstract No. 137, City of Graham, Young County, Texas. Said 0.259 acres also being the land conveyed to W. H. Reeves, County Judge of said county recorded in Vol. 104 Pg. 320 of the Deed Records of said county. Said 0.259 acres described in metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at a 3/8 inch iron rod set at the northeast corner of a tract of land known as the Methodist Episcopal Church Tract conveyed to the City of Graham recorded in Vol. 459 Pg. 428 of the Deed Records of said county from which a 5/8 inch iron rod found at the northeast corner of Tract 3 described in a deed to Anthony D. Hogan recorded in Inst. No. 23002292 bears N 51°48'19" W 114.02 feet;

THENCE S 89°40'48" E 56.31 feet with a boundary line of the Alonzo Hill Subdivision recorded in Vol. 1 Pg. 248 of the Plat Records of said county to a 3/8 inch iron rod set for the northeast corner of said cemetery;

THENCE S 0°19'12" W 200.0 feet with a boundary line of said subdivision and the east line of said cemetery to a 3/8 inch iron set for corner in the north right-of-way line of U. S. Highway 380;

THENCE N 89°40'48" W 56.31 feet with said right-of-way line to a 3/8 inch iron rod set for corner in a large rock;

THENCE N 0°19'12" E 200.0 feet with the east line of said church tract to the point of beginning containing 0.259 acres more or less.
