

**NOTICE OF FORECLOSURE SALE**

**ASSERT AND PROTECT YOUR RIGHTS AS A MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES. IF YOU ARE, OR YOUR SPOUSE IS, SERVING ON ACTIVE MILITARY DUTY, INCLUDING ACTIVE MILITARY DUTY AS A MEMBER OF THE TEXAS NATIONAL GUARD OR THE NATIONAL GUARD OF ANOTHER STATE OR AS A MEMBER OF A RESERVE COMPONENT OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES, PLEASE SEND WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY SERVICE TO THE SENDER OF THIS NOTICE IMMEDIATELY.**

Notice is hereby given of a public foreclosure sale.

1. Property to Be Sold. The property to be sold is described as follows:

Lot No. Seven (7) and Eight (8), Block No. 75, Original Town of Holliday, an Addition to the City of Holliday, Archer County, Texas, according to the plat of record in Volume 1, Page 4, Archer County Deed Records, and being commonly known as 203 E. South Street, Holliday, Texas 76366.

2. Instrument to be Foreclosed. The instrument to be foreclosed is the Texas

Home Equity Security Instrument, indexed at Document Number 141454, Official Public Records, Archer County, Texas, and the Texas Home Equity Affidavit and Agreement, indexed at Document Number 141455, Official Public Records, Archer County, Texas (all of which is hereinafter referred to as the "Security Instrument"), as authorized by the Default Order granted on June 4, 2018, in cause number PR-2017-0014, in the County Court of Archer County, Texas.

3. Date, Time, and Place of Sale. The sale is scheduled to be held at the

following date, time, and place:

Date: July 3, 2018

Time: The sale shall begin no earlier than 11:00 A.M. or no later than three hours thereafter. The sale shall be completed by no later than 4:00 P.M.

Place: Archer County Courthouse Annex, 112 E. Walnut, Archer City, Archer County, Texas, at the following location: North entrance of the courthouse annex, or as designated by the County Commissioners.

4. Terms of Sale. The sale will be conducted as a public auction to the highest bidder for cash, subject to the provisions of the Security Instrument, permitting the Beneficiary thereunder to have the bid credited to the Note up to the amount of the unpaid debt secured by the Security Instrument at the time of sale.

Those desiring to purchase the property will need to demonstrate their ability to pay cash on the day the property is sold.

The sale will be made expressly subject to any title matters set forth in the Security Instrument, but prospective bidders are reminded that by law the sale will necessarily be made subject to all prior matters of record affecting the property, if any, to the extent that they remain in force and effect and have not been subordinated to the Security Instrument. The sale shall not cover any part of the property that has been released of public record from the lien of the Security Instrument. Prospective bidders are strongly urged to examine the applicable property records to determine the nature and extent of such matters, if any.

Pursuant to the Security Instrument, the Beneficiary has the right to direct the Trustee and/or Substitute Trustee to sell the property in one or more parcels and/or to sell all or only part of the property.

Pursuant to section 51.009 of the Texas Property Code, the property will be sold in "as is, where is" condition, without any express or implied warranties, except as to the warranties of title (if any) provided for under the Security Instrument. Prospective bidders are advised to conduct an independent investigation of the nature and physical condition of the property.

Pursuant to section 51.0075 of the Texas Property Code, the Trustee and/or Substitute Trustee reserves the right to set further reasonable conditions for conducting the sale. Any such further conditions shall be announced before bidding is opened for the first sale of the day held by the Trustee or any Substitute Trustee.

5. Type of Sale. The sale is a foreclosure sale being conducted pursuant to the

power of sale granted by the Security Instrument executed by BETTY NICKERSON, a single woman, dated July 18, 2016, and duly recorded in the office of the County Clerk of Archer County, Texas, in Document Number 141454, and authorized by the Default Order granted on June 4, 2018, by the County Court of Archer County, Texas, in cause number PR-2017-0014.


6. Obligations Secured. The Security Instrument provides that it secures the payment of the indebtedness and obligations therein described (collectively, the "Obligations") including but not limited to the Note ("Note") dated July 18, 2016, in the original principal amount of \$54,400.00, executed by BETTY NICKERSON, and payable to the order of UNION SQUARE CREDIT UNION. UNION SQUARE CREDIT UNION is the current owner and holder of the Obligations and is the Beneficiary under the Security Instrument.

As of June 5, 2018, there was owed \$58,191.40 on the Note, being principal, interest, and attorney's fees in the following amounts: \$53,603.06 in principal; \$2,887.14 in interest; \$201.20 in late fees; and at least \$1,500.00 in attorney's fees, with additional interest accruing at \$5.96 per day thereafter. Applicable Trustee's fees, ad valorem taxes, insurance, and other expenses, may be added to the amount owed.

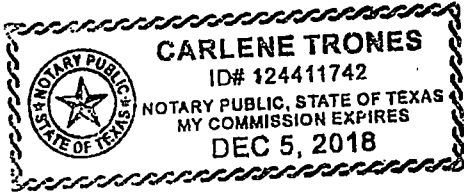
