To the registered, qualified voters of Culberson County-Allamoore Independent School District, Culberson and Hudspeth Counties, Texas:

TAKE NOTICE that a special election will be held in the Culberson County-Allamoore Independent School District on November 8, 2022, concerning the ratification of the ad valorem tax rate of \$1.13 in Culberson County-Allamoore Independent School District for the current year, a rate that will result in an increase of 100.51% percent in maintenance and operations tax revenue for the district for the current year as compared to the preceding year, which is an additional \$30,594,998.

On Election Day, voters may vote at the locations listed at *Exhibit A*.
