DeWitt County Commissioners Court met in regular session April 11, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. in the County Courtroom at the DeWitt County Courthouse in Cuero, Texas, with the following members present:

CALL TO ORDER; PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE & INVOCATION

Judge Fowler called the meeting to order and let everyone in the pledge of allegiance. Mr. Afflerbach gave the invocation.

NEW BUSINESS:

PUBLIC HEARING (No. 1)

Public hearing held to provide opportunity for public comments on a proposal to expand the existing 30 MPH speed limit on Cheapside Road in Precinct No. 1 for increased public safety. No one was present to speak for or against.

CLOSE PUBLIC HEARING (No. 2)

Judge Fowler closed the public hearing.

RULE ON PUBLIC HEARING (No. 3)

MOTION: Mr. Afflerbach made a motion to approve expanding the existing 30 MPH speed limit zone on Cheapside Road for an additional ½ mile on each direction. Mr. Kaiser seconded the motion. After discussion, Mr. Afflerbach withdrew his motion. Court took no action.

JOINT ELECTION AGREEMENT (No. 5)

MOTION: Mr. Kaiser made a motion to ratify the Joint Election Agreement to provide election services for the Joint General Election on May 7, 2016 between DeWitt County, by and through the DeWitt County Elections Administrator, and the City of Yorktown, Yorktown Independent School District and the City of Cuero. Mr. Pilchick seconded the motion. Motion carried on a vote of 5-0.

DE WITT COUNTY HISTORICAL COMMISSION (No. 6)

MOTION: Mr. Kaiser made a motion to approve the appointment of an additional member to the DeWitt County Historical Commission for the remaining 2015-2016 term of Cheryl Rabel Scott. Mr. Pilchick seconded the motion. Motion carried on a vote of 5-0.

REQUEST FOR CAPITAL CREDITS (No. 7)

MOTION: Mr. Afflerbach made a motion to authorize County Judge Daryl L. Fowler to complete and sign the County Request for Capital Credits form pursuant to Property Tax Code §74.602 and acknowledge that the use of the funds received will be in compliance with the provisions of Texas Local Government Code Section 381.004 for the 2015 reporting year, beneficiary to be Golden Crescent CASA. Mr. Kaiser seconded the motion. Motion carried on a vote of 5-0.


LEGISLATIVE UPDATE (No. 17)
