## CALL TO ORDER; PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE & INOVOCATION

Judge Fowler called the meeting to order and led everyone in the pledge of allegiance. Mr. Randle gave the invocation.

#### PUBLIC HEARING (No 1)

Public hearing held to provide opportunity for public comments on the implementation of Vote Centers in DeWitt County for the November 2017 General Election. Approximately 12 citizens were present for the public hearing. Election Administrator Blanca McBride answered questions from the citizens concerning the Vote Centers.
