Resolution Approving a Joint General Primary Election on March 5, 2024, and any Runoff Primary Election

WHEREAS, Section 172.126, Texas Election Code, provides that the primary elections in a county may be conducted jointly at the regular polling places designated for the general election for state and county officers, and that the decision to conduct a joint general primary election or runoff primary election, as applicable, must be made by majority vote of the full membership of the Commissioners Court and with the unanimous approval of the County Elections Administrator and the county chair of each political party required to nominate candidates by primary election; and

WHEREAS, the Fayette County Elections Administrator, the County Chair of the Fayette County Democratic Party, and the County Chair of the Fayette County Republican/Party unanimously approve; and

WHEREAS, in order for said district to satisfy the requirement of Texas Election Code 42.002, it is desirable that said elections be held jointly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Commissioners Court of Fayette County, Texas approves a joint election on March 5, 2024 (and any runoff election) to be held with the Republican Party and the Democrat Party, pursuant to Section 271.002 of the Texas Election Code, said elections to be held jointly.
