RE: Partial Manual Count after the May 24 Joint Primary Runoff Election

Pursuant to Section 127.201(a) of the Texas Election Code (the “Code”), the general custodian of election records in an election in which an electronic voting system is used must conduct a partial manual count.

The partial manual count applies to election day ballots, early voting in-person ballots, and early voting by-mail ballots.

The partial manual count is required for all counties that automatically tabulate their ballots using an optical/digital scanner (DS200 and DS 450). In Fayette County, the DS 200 and DS 450 are optical/digital scanners used in Early Voting and in the Central Counting Station to scan and tabulate paper ballots.

The precincts identified for the partial manual count are:

- 112 Plum
- 315 Cistern
- 425 Schulenburg

The partial manual count will be conducted on Thursday, May 26 at 9:00 am at the Fayette County Elections Office, 275 Ellinger Road, La Grange, Texas.
