## Tuesday, May 24<sup>th</sup>, 2016

*(for all new registrations or registrations needing to be updated)*

### **EARLY VOTING:**

**Monday, May 16<sup>th</sup> through Friday, May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2016 8:00 am to 5:00 pm**  
Location: Fayette County Courthouse; 151 N. Washington St., Room 108;  
La Grange, Tx *(ADA entrance on west side)*

**BALLOTS BY MAIL:** In order to vote by mail, a voter must first complete and turn in an “*Application to Vote by Mail*” before a ballot can be sent. *Applications* for the Primary Runoff election, or an *Annual Application for the 2016 year*, may be requested by phone: **979-968-6563**, downloaded from the Fayette County Website: [www.co.fayette.tx.us](http://www.co.fayette.tx.us), emailed to [elections@co.fayette.tx.us](mailto:elections@co.fayette.tx.us), or picked up in person at the Elections office, Room 108 in the Fayette County Courthouse 151 N. Washington St.; La Grange, TX.

Completed *applications* must be received by 5 pm Friday, May 13<sup>th</sup>, in the Elections Administration office.

Before the start of Early Voting, applications can be received by mail, email, fax, or hand delivered to the Elections Administration office;\*

*(After Early Voting starts, the completed application cannot be hand delivered but can only be received by mail, email, or fax.*

\* *Completed applications can be hand delivered in person by only the voter themselves; no one can turn in another voter’s application*

Last day to receive completed *applications*, IN OFFICE (NOT postmarked),  
**Friday, May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2016**

Voted ballots by mail must be received in the elections office by mail or contract carrier by 7:00 pm on Election Day, or, hand delivered, in person with Photo ID, to the Elections Administrator’s office ONLY, NOT any voting pct, between 7am and 7pm. and must be accompanied by a Photo ID.

NO voted mail ballots may be accepted at any of the polling locations on Election Day.

### **Election Day: Polls open 7:00 am to 7:00 pm**

*(No voting at Courthouse on Election Day—voters must vote in the precinct where they are registered)*
