

## Covid-19 Testing in Fayette County

Fayette County, in cooperation with the National Guard and TDEM is continuing to advocate for testing for those that wish to be tested due to possible covid-19 symptoms or exposure to suspected covid-19 patients.

Next week, we have an exciting opportunity to test anyone in the county that wishes to be tested. On Wednesday June 17 from 8am-5pm testing will be performed at the Wolters Park in Schulenburg. Citizens can either be tested in their cars, or can walk-up to be tested. There is no cost for the testing. There is no residency requirement for the testing. Wolters Park is located at 1103 Bohlmann Ave, Schulenburg TX, 78956

Yesterday, June 12<sup>th</sup>, five teams of military testing experts came to Fayette County and tested all of our nursing homes. In total 679 citizens were tested. Of those 311 were residents of the nursing homes and 368 were staff members of the nursing homes. We are awaiting the results of the testing and will share the results once they are available.

Last week, we partnered with local healthcare professionals and tested an entire independent living facility due to concern of a possible exposure. All of the residents and staff that were tested resulted in negative tests.
