



Fire Marshal for Franklin County, Texas

Job Description:

Investigate all types of fires, bomb threats, explosions, etc. within the County but outside the municipalities in the County, and adjoining counties as called upon, that damage or destroy property, to find the cause and origin: if found to be suspicious or intentionally ignited, collects and preserves evidence, statements and facts and prepares and presents findings to the proper Courts.

Enforces all County and State regulations that relate to fires, explosions or damage of any kind caused by fire or explosion.

Assists local, State, Federal and private investigators with investigating fires, bomb threats, explosions, etc.

Emergency Management Coordinator for Franklin County

Job Description:

Carries out all aspects of Emergency Management responsibilities.

Is responsible for the preparation of Emergency Management Base Plan, Annexes and Appendices, which as closely as possible meet State standards.

Is responsible for the planning for, coordination of, response to, mitigation of and recovery from disasters or potential disasters.

Is responsible for receiving and disseminating any and all warnings of incidents, real or potential, of natural, manmade, technological or nuclear which may involve Franklin County to the proper persons or agencies.

Works with individuals and agencies in storm spotting during severe weather to verify any related property damage or casualties and to report to the National Weather Service.

Coordinates disaster damage assessment reports and advises the County Judge and/or Commissioners Court of any requirements or reports.

Serve as staff advisor to the County Judge on Emergency Management activities and operations.

Serves as the direction and control manager of the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) when it is activated.

OSSF Designated Representative for Franklin County

Job Description:

The Designated Representative will review plans for constructing, altering, extending or repairing each OSSF, issuing permits and inspecting system installation.

Shall respond to complaints to ensure that an OSSF meets minimum standards.

Shall enforce the rules and regulations of the Texas Health and Safety Code, Chapter 366

Shall review Variance requests to ensure compliance with the requirements of the permitting authority

Ensure maintenance of accurate records of permitting, fees, inspections, maintenance, reports and complaints.
