There are two additional confirmed cases of the COVID-19 virus in Freestone County, making a total of 3. The individuals are male, one 40-49, one 30-39, on 20-29, and they live in Teague, Texas.

I and many others have long believed that the virus was here and that there were active cases here but not identified possibly because they were mild cases. We must be even more careful to protect ourselves and others. We do that by following all the recommendations and requirements from the state, federal and local governments to **stay at home** except for essential services or engaging in essential daily activities while continuing to **practice social distancing** and continuing to **follow personal health hygiene practices**, such as **washing your hands**. **Wear a mask or a cloth face covering** whenever you are out in public and cannot maintain 6' social distancing. **Limit to only one person per household** to handle essential functions, such as grocery shopping, whenever possible, to limit exposure for your family and for the workers who are serving you in this critical time.

The next two weeks are important. Freestone County is doing a good job. **Please don't slack off.**

We, as a County, are all in this together. We can show this support by be faithful to follow the precautions.
