Judge Ward also appeared before the Waco Court of Appeals, the Supreme Court of Texas and the United States District Courts of the Western District.

Judge Ward is deeply involved within the communities she now serves as District Judge. She enjoys supporting fundraisers for the youth of our community and has served as Past Vice-President of the CenTex Bar Association, Past Board Member of the Limestone County Cancer Support Group, and the Mexia Women's Friday Club. Each year, she and her family also organize the Annual Jason Ward Memorial Golf Tournament that has awarded over \$220,000 in scholarships to graduating seniors. She is also a member of the First Baptist Church of Mexia.
