The Commissioners discussed this agenda item thoroughly. They wanted to make sure for one, the sheriffs office needed the additional help, and two, they could adequately be trained and used during this pandemic. The Sheriff Albert Deleon, along with Jail Administrator Bosquez argued that there is no reason to have these new jailers if they were only temporary. Jail administrator Bosquez stated that the six weeks they proposed was the amount of time they would need to train the people. The Commissioners decided to change the budget item to make the positions last till the end of the fiscal year. The Commissioners also talked about waiving the time period for health care coverage but ultimately decided they will discuss it in another Commissioners Court meeting that will be held at 2:00 p.m. of the same day.

Consider/take action on selling all of Frio County's surplus Personal Protective Equipment to the Frio County Hospital District.

There was talk of selling any, and all equipment that could be sparred, or was old. The talk was for \$1.00 total. However, it was decided to wait and see what inventory we had of the equipment before anything was sold, and if it would actually aid the hospital district. No action.
