



**GRAY COUNTY DISASTER DECLARATION FEBRUARY 27, 2024**

**WHEREAS**, the **COUNTY OF GRAY** on the **27<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF FEBRUARY, 2024**, has suffered widespread damage resulting from wildfires causing widespread damage throughout Gray County and;

**WHEREAS**, the **COUNTY JUDGE OF GRAY COUNTY** has determined that measures must be taken to protect or rehabilitate property and to document the widespread damage of personal and public property;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF GRAY COUNTY:**

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for **GRAY COUNTY, TEXAS** pursuant to §418.108(a) of the *Texas Government Code*.

Pursuant to §418.018(b) of the *Texas Government Code*, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the **COMMISSIONERS COURT of GRAY COUNTY, TEXAS**.

Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the *Texas Government Code*, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the **GRAY COUNTY CLERK**.

Pursuant to §418.018(d) of the *Texas Government Code*, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the **Gray County Emergency Management Plan**.

**THIS PROCLAMATION SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY FROM AND AFTER ITS ISSUANCE.**
