ITEM NO. 1 – Call to order – All stand if convenient

ITEM NO. 2 – Canvass Results for Special Election for Senate, District 30.

County Judge, John C. Bullock then delivered the Election Results of the September 29, 2020 Special Election for Senate, District 30 to Commissioners Court, the local canvassing Authority. Lauren Sullivan, Election Administrator, made a report to Commissioner Court that

- 2137 total votes
- 23 provisional ballots were casted with only
- 3 provisional ballots casted that did not qualified were not registered to vote.

THEN, Commissioner Jimmy Wiley moved to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Matt Pruitt and carried 5-0.


