ITEM NO. 3. "PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED BUDGET AND PROPOSED TAX RATE" AS REQUIRED BY TRUTH IN TAXATION

A tax rate of \$.5863563 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Young County. This rate exceeds the No-New-Revenue tax rate. State law requires that a public hearing be held by the governing body before a budget may be adopted or a vote may be taken on the proposed tax rate.

A hearing to formally adopt the budget and set the tax rates for maintenance and operation and for debt service has been set in the manner and time as required by Truth-in-Taxation, Texas Government Code, Chapter 26 and Local Government Code, Chapter 111, for August 26, 2024 @ 9:3 AM in the Young County Courtroom Room 106, Graham Texas.

Announcement calculation of the Tax Rates for Young County, Texas, were completed August 5, 2024, as follows:

Proposed Tax Rate- .586353 No-New-Revenue Tax Rate- .553763 Voter Approval Rate- .632547
