The *Deed of Trust* provides that it secures the payment of the indebtedness and obligations therein described (collectively the "Obligations") including, but not limited to:

- (1) Real Estate Lien Note dated June 15, 2015, executed by Mark Kalaj, as Borrower, payable to Graham Industrial Association, Inc., a Texas corporation, as Lender, and in the original principal sum of four hundred twenty-seven thousand five hundred and no/100 dollars (\$427,500.00) (the "Note"); and,
- (2) All renewals and extensions of the *Note*.

Graham Industrial Association, Inc., is the current owner and holder of the Obligations and is the Beneficiary under the *Deed of Trust*.

As of <u>April 18, 2017</u>, there was owed <u>\$399,662.95</u> in principal, plus all unpaid accrued interest and late charges. 
