



Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase

The Young County will hold two public hearings on a proposal to increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding tax year by 3.3 percent. Your individual taxes may increase at a greater or lesser rate, or even decrease, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all other property and the tax rate is adopted.

The first public hearing will be held on 08/12/2013 09:30 AM at Young County Court House Room 106.

The second public hearing will be held on 08/19/2013 09:30 AM at Young County Court House Room 106.

The members of the governing body voted on the proposal to consider the tax increase as follows:

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in Young County last year was \$54438. Based on last years tax rate of \$0.590168 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed last year on the average home was \$321.28.

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in Young County this year is \$64790. If the governing body adopts the effective tax rate for this year of \$0.54328 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be \$351.99.

If the governing body adopts the proposed tax rate of \$ 0.590864 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be \$382.82.

Members of the public are encouraged to attend the hearings and express their views.

Special Provisions if Applicable

Criminal Justice Mandate (for counties):

The Young County Auditor certifies that Young County has spent \$0 in the previous 12 months beginning July 1, 2012 for the maintenance and operations cost of keeping inmates sentenced to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. Young County Sheriff has provided information on these costs, minus the state revenues received for reimbursement of such costs.

Enhanced Indigents Health Care Expenditure (use if applicable):

The Young County spent \$0 from July 1 to 2012 on enhanced indigent health care at the increased minimum eligibility standards, less the amount of state assistance. For the current tax year, the amount of increase above last year's enhanced indigent health care expenditures is \$0.
