Invocation and Pledge

Comm. Hunt opened the meeting with prayer and Judge Sklar led the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance of the United States of America.

Receive various county reports, news and information.

Comm. Belicek had an update from Any Louderback, Sherriff that SB354, concerning court authority to disburse payment of county funds for salaries or expenses, proposed by Sen. Judith Zaffirini had no opposition and would likely be signed in September. Monica Foster, Tax Assessor-Collector informed the Court that the office would be closed on Thursday, March 14, 2014 from 11:30am-1:00pm for a reginal meeting being hosted in their office. Rick Boone, Chief Deputy, reported that they had their first road closing at 1593 and 426 with minimal issues and would have another closing on Thursday. He reported that EISD was very happy with the SRO program that was recently implemented. He also updated the Court on ongoing hazardous traffic conditions in front of Formosa. He stated that U-Turn signs would be installed so that

violations can be enforced. Deputies are issuing an average of twenty tickets a day. Comm. Bubela commended the S.O. on the presentation they put on for Ganado ISD on cell phone misuse. Judge Sklar added that certificates were received for county officials and employees who attended the Emergency Management workshop, for Mrs. Robinson who completed a Mental Health First Aid course and Wayne Hunt who completed a Commissioners Education course.
