Hunt to adopt the Jackson County FY 2025 budget that will raise more total property tax revenue than in the previous year by \$45,975.00 or .30% increase and of the amount of \$56,407.00 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year. This tax rate will raise more taxes for maintenance and operations than last years tax rate. Motion carried unanimously by a record vote.
