Kurt Janica - Fire Chief, was present via phone to give his input on the conditions and concern for possible fires.

A motion was made by Comm. Bubela, seconded by Comm. Frenzel to enact a Burn Ban and when conditions allow, authorize the County Judge to rescind. Motion carried.
